

The Sixteenth Annual Robinson Talent Show

It's that time of year again for our Riptides to show off their many talents! This year's show will be held on **Tuesday, May 22nd** at 4:00 p.m. at the Mira Costa High School auditorium with a mandatory dress rehearsal after school on **Monday, May 21st**.

Please return the sign-up sheet to the office no later than Friday, March 30th. Please do not email your application. If you miss this deadline, you will not be able to participate in the show.

Talent Show Procedures

Parents, PLEASE REMEMBER THAT NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED ON THE MIRA COSTA CAMPUS. It is illegal to have or bring alcohol on a high school campus.

Also, for the benefit of all of the involved families, please use discretion in selecting songs. Please review your child's act before attending the rehearsal to make certain that it is appropriate for an elementary school audience.

In order for a talent show entry form to be accepted, it must describe the act to be performed and if applicable, must have the lyrics attached. Repeat acts from previous years are strongly discouraged. Acts will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Should there be several groups interested in performing the identical act or song, the first group to sign-up will be allowed to perform the song. Due to this possibility, any act performing a popular song or act should have a backup in mind should that song/act be already chosen.

The following points are important to remember:

1. **All songs are subject to approval and must adhere to strict family friendly content guidelines. This includes lyrics, implied lyrics, dance movements, and appropriate dress/costumes.**
2. All acts are limited to **two minutes** and each performing group is responsible for cutting their own music (this can be easily done on i-tunes) and emailing it to fbenvo@aol.com by **Monday, May 14th**. Additionally, each act is responsible for its own props and must provide a poster board. **Poster boards are due in the office on Monday, May 21st**.
3. **K-4th grade students are limited to only one act.** 5th grade students may participate in two acts but not two solo acts.
4. Each act must have an adult sponsor who is responsible for arranging and supervising rehearsals, appropriateness of music and dress, preparedness and for the behavior of the members of the act. For large group acts, more than one sponsor may be necessary. **One sponsor for each act must sit with the student(s) during the show until his/her act is completed.** **Please show proper respect for all of the acts and do not allow the kids to run around the auditorium unattended while the show is in progress. Participants not in their seats they will lose their privilege of performing.**
